

## East Hoathly with Halland Photography competition

1. 3 categories under 10s, 10-16, over 16
2. This competition is open to residents of East Hoathly with Halland Council Parish.
3. All information detailing how to enter this Competition forms part of these terms and conditions. It is a condition of entry that all rules are accepted as final and that the competitor agrees to abide by these rules. The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into. Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
4. There are two entry routes to this Competition as follows: by email to clerk e-mail address. Entries must be labelled with the entrant's name and location of the photograph and image files must be 200 dpi and between 1MB and 3MB. Entrants should include their own name, address and telephone number. The second route is via hand to be delivered to Verne in the post office at East Hoathly.
5. All entries must be received by the advertised closing time and date (start date 2<sup>nd</sup> April 2019, closing date 24<sup>th</sup> June 2019, judges' decision announced 29<sup>th</sup> July Parish Council meeting)
6. All images submitted must be the work of the individual submitting them and must not have won a prize in any other photographic competition. It is the responsibility of each entrant to ensure that any images they submit which include an identifiable person or persons have been taken with the permission of the person or persons pictured and do not infringe the copyright of any third party or any laws. Entrants must warrant that the photograph they are submitting is their own work and that they own the copyright for it.
7. By entering competition permission is granted to use the image for parish council resource.
8. Only five entries per person. Late, illegible, incomplete, defaced or corrupt entries will not be accepted. No responsibility can be accepted for lost entries and proof of transmission will not be accepted as proof of receipt. Entries must not be sent through agencies or third parties.
9. The winning entry will be that that is judged to be the most visually appealing, original and self-explanatory. The winner will be notified within seven days of the closing date of the competition.
10. One entrant from each category will win £50.
11. Events may occur that render the Competition itself or the awarding of the prizes impossible due to reasons beyond the control of the Promoter and accordingly the Promoter may at its absolute discretion vary or amend the Competition and the entrant agrees that no liability shall attach to the Promoter as a result thereof.
12. Judges are Victoria Albuquerque, Carolyn Robins and photographer Jim Holden (awaiting his acceptance of this role), their decision is final.
